Eliza ROBINS is yet another woman who married into an important family, that of John CHAMBERS, a school-teacher who came to Hobart, and then one of his sons, Alfred CHAMBERS moved to Victoria, where he married, and then came to Adelaide in South Australia. Eliza was born in 1807 in Abington, Berkshire, and she married John CHAMBERS in Oxford in 1831. Alfred and Eliza were described as cousins, but I am yet to find the connection. John had trained as a teacher in the Methodist tradition, and he was proudly teetotal. They had six children in England, mostly in Woolwich, Kent, but three died in this period. In 1841, John saw a notice inviting applications for teachers in Tasmania, and they set off in August 1841. Anne's great grandfather, appropriately named Alfred Ocean CHAMBERS, was born on the voyage to Hobart. This must have been quite a challenging voyage for Eliza.

William ROBINS b c1780

Eliza's father was William ROBINS, and he is only identified on Eliza's baptism records, together with Eliza's mother Dinah. William married Dinah?, presumably before Eliza's birth in 1807. There are too many possible records for their marriage and baptism, to be sure of where and when they were baptised and married.

Eliza ROBINS b1807

Eliza ROBINS was born in 1807, in Abington, Berkshire. She married Alfred CHAMBERS in 1831, in Oxford, which is only about 10km North of Abington. They were living in Kent at the time of the 1841 census, and is where five of their six UK children were born. Sadly, three had died by this time, so was that a reason why they wanted to move somewhere? They did move, because Alfred, a teacher in the Methodist Church tradition, found a teaching position in Tasmania, Australia, and the family duly set off soon after the 1841 census was taken.
